As a new network provider who provides Neonatal care, we want to advise you about Missouri Care's existing partnership with ProgenyHealth, a company which specializes in Neonatal Care Coordination Services.

Under this agreement ProgenyHealth's Neonatologists, Pediatricians and Neonatal Nurse Care Managers work closely with the Missouri Care clinical team to promote healthy outcomes for Missouri Care's premature and medically complex newborns.

Following this notification, Progeny Neonatal Nurse Care Managers will work in close collaboration with the Missouri Care team and your designated onsite staff to provide ongoing telephonic care coordination services throughout the inpatient stay.

CMPCN provides delegated medical management services including case management, utilization management and disease management for Missouri Care members ages 0-20 who reside in the following counties: **Bates, Cass, Cedar, Clay, Henry, Jackson, Johnson, Lafayette, Platte, Polk, Ray, St. Clair and Vernon**. CMPCN will continue to provide care management of NICU stays for CMPCN members separate from the Missouri Care/ProgenyHealth partnership.
