## Important changes to advanced reproductive technologies (ART) benefits

We want to keep you informed. Here's what you need to know.

For members whose benefit plan requires trials of ovulation induction (OI) prior to advanced reproductive technologies (ART)/IVF cycle authorization, the number of OI cycles required before proceeding to IVF under most<sup>1</sup> benefit plans has changed.

Effective **July 14, 2020**, ART procedures are considered medically necessary for women with infertility who have failed to conceive after the following number of OI cycles:

- For women 38 years of age or older, no trial of ovarian stimulation is required
- For women 37 years of age or younger, three cycles of ovarian stimulation (with or without intrauterine insemination)
